It was moved by Ms. Kremer, seconded by Ms. Shelton, and carried to approve the Minutes of the May 24, 2018 Administrative Appeals Committee Meeting.

Mr. Peercy noted the necessity of closed session for the purpose of reviewing the administrative appeals of Administrative Action Numbers: 17-T-04, 17-PS-15, 17-PS-18, 17-PS-12, and 17-PS-11.

Recommended Order, and to dismiss this action.

It was moved by Ms. Shelton, seconded by Ms. Kremer, and carried unanimously, that the Committee members having considered the record, including the recommended order and any exceptions duly filed, in the case of Administrative Action Number: 17-PS-12, to accept the Hearing Officer's Report, Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and to deny claimant's appeal and affirming Kentucky Retirement Systems' determination. Furthermore, the Board having reviewed Claimant's Request for Oral Argument, hereby overrules the Request for Oral Argument.

It was moved by Ms. Shelton, seconded by Ms. Kremer, and carried unanimously, that the Committee members having considered the record, including the recommended order and any exceptions duly filed, in the case of Administrative Action Number: 17-PS-11, to remand this case in order for the hearing officer to issue a new Recommended Order.
