It was moved by Ms. Shelton, seconded by Mr. Powell, and carried unanimously, that the Committee members having considered the record, including the Hearing Officer's Recommended Order Dismissing Appeal and any exceptions duly filed, in the case of Administrative Action Number: 19-D-23, to accept the Hearing Officer's Recommended Order Dismissing Appeal, and to dismiss Claimant's application for disability retirement benefits.
