At the meeting of the Disability Appeals Committee, held on June 13, 2018, the following members were present: Betty Pendergrass, Chair, Jerry Powell, and Donna Shelton, Proxy on behalf of Thomas Stephens.

In addition, those present were Erin Surratt, KRS, Liza Welch, KRS, Alan Hurst, KRS, and Tracy Chambers, Recording Secretary.

It was moved by Ms. Shelton, seconded by Mr. Powell, and carried to approve the Minutes of the April 16, 2018 Disability Appeals Committee Meeting.

Ms. Pendergrass noted the necessity of closed session for the purpose of reviewing the disability applications of Administrative Action Numbers: 17-D-32, 16-D-48, 17-D-43, 17-D-37, and 17-D-10.

Following discussion in closed session, the Committee returned to open session, whereafter the following transpired.

It was moved by Ms. Shelton, seconded by Mr. Powell, and carried unanimously, that the Committee members having considered the record, including the recommended order and any exceptions duly filed, in the case of Administrative Action Number: 17-D-32, to accept the Hearing Officer's Report, Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and to deny claimant's application for disability retirement benefits.

It was moved by Ms. Shelton, seconded by Mr. Powell, and carried unanimously, that the Committee members having considered the record, including the recommended order and any exceptions duly filed, in the case of Administrative Action Number: 16-D-48, to accept the Hearing Officer's Report, as modified in the Board Final Order, and to deny claimant's application for disability retirement benefits.

It was moved by Ms. Shelton, seconded by Ms. Pendergrass, and carried by a majority, that the Committee members having considered the record, including the recommended order and any exceptions duly filed, in the case of Administrative Action Number: 17-D-43, to accept the Hearing Officer's Report, Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and to approve claimant's application for disability retirement benefits, with a review in one year. Mr. Powell abstained.

It was moved by Ms. Shelton, seconded by Mr. Powell, and carried unanimously, that the Committee members having considered the record, including the recommended order and any exceptions duly filed, in the case of Administrative Action Number: 17-D-37, to accept the Hearing Officer's Report, Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and to deny claimant's application for disability retirement benefits.

It was moved by Ms. Shelton, seconded by Mr. Powell, and carried unanimously, that the Committee members having considered the record, including the Hearing Officer's Order and any exceptions duly filed, in the case of Administrative Action Number: 17-D-10, to accept the Hearing Officer's Order, and to dismiss claimant's application for disability retirement benefits.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:26 A.M., E.T. to meet on August 27, 2018 at 10:00 A.M., E.T.
