It was moved by Mr. Rich, seconded by Ms. Shelton, and carried unanimously, that the Committee members having considered the record, including the Hearing Officer's Order of Dismissal and any exceptions duly filed, in the case of Administrative Action Number: 14-D-19, to accept the Hearing Officer's Order of Dismissal and to dismiss claimant's application for disability retirement benefits with prejudice. Mr. Bowman recused from participation because of prior involvement in this matter.
